#### Project Nepal 2011/2012: 'Climb Mount Everest' Fundraisers

Dear Parents,

During the last week of the autumn term, Form 11 students are organising two sponsored events to raise money for the community of Chituan, Nepal.

The goal will be to reach the height of Mount Everest (8435m) using the climbing wall in the Sports Hall. Details of the two sponsored events are outlined below:

#### **Challenge 1:**

The Form 11 Nepal group will attempt to traverse the height of Mount Everest (8435m) in the quickest time possible in the **Sports Hall** on **Saturday, 10<sup>th</sup> December** at **11am**. We would welcome your support for this challenge as either a spectator or participant and request a small entry donation of €2.

#### Challenge 2:

All students from **Forms 4-12** will take part in a sponsored climb challenge from **Monday**, 12<sup>th</sup> – **Friday**, 16<sup>th</sup> **December** during their PE/Games lessons, before school, during lunch time and after school. Using the climbing wall in the Sports Hall, their goal will be to traverse as many metres as they can over the course of the week. They will keep a record of the total metres climbed and results will go towards both an individual and inter-house competition. There will be a prize for the greatest distance climbed for the individual boy and girl in each year group. You are invited to participate and climb with and for your child during the before and after school sessions.

#### How else can I support this event?

For both challenges **all** students are encouraged to raise funds through sponsorship forms where friends and family can make small donations to sponsor students for each metre they climb. Please find attached a sponsorship form for your son/daughter to start raising funds.
